



Healthcare Kits for UMCOR...

St. John's United Methodist Women are collecting items for Health Kits for UMCOR. The health kits are used by UMCOR in places where people do not have ready access to many essential supplies for everyday life. *You can help us out by donating a whole kit or individual items and we will make up the kits.* Health kits provide basic necessities to people who have been forced to leave their home because of human conflict or natural disaster. These kits are also used as learning tools in personal hygiene and literacy.

Health Kit

- 1 hand towel (15" x 25" up to 17" x 27")
- 1 washcloth
- 1 comb (large & sturdy, not pocket size)
- 1 nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery boards or toenail clippers)
- 1 bath- size bar of soap (3 OZ. and up)
- 1 toothbrush (single brushes only in original wrapper, no child-size brushes)
- 1 dollar to go towards toothpaste
- 6 adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages

Place these items inside a sealed one-gallon plastic bag and put on the shelf over the coat rack in the lobby (opposite the kitchen).

Note: All items must be new! *We need items by April 23rd.*
